ELECTRONICS RECYCLING: Recycle your computers, TVs, bulbs, batteries, cell phones and other electronics. These items contain both hazardous and useful materials and should be properly recycled.

COMPOST AND YARD WASTE: Quality composts and woodchips at a reasonable fee, free materials also available! Deliveries to your area! Yard waste drop off sites to accept your compostable yard wastes items.

MERCURY REDUCTION : Help keep this toxic material out of our water, air and soil. This free program accepts mercury containing items. Exchange your thermometers for one digital fever thermometer!

HAZARDOUS WASTE CLEAN SWEEP: Held for a day in the middle of May. This is the proper way to dispose of oil based paints, solvents, pesticides and other hazardous chemicals.

EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH: A free service to promote recycling in Manitowoc County. Free information, tours and presentations are available.

TIRES COLLECTION: Each September tires are collected for a small fee. Old tires can be reused and do environmental harm when left in stockpiles for a long time.

PHARMACEUTICAL COLLECTIONS: Programs held throughout the year to help you safely dispose of unwanted medication without flushing them or throwing them in the garbage.

WHAT MATERIALS ARE ACCEPTED AND HOW DO I PREPARE THEM FOR RECYCLING?

PLASTICS

1&2: Check for the neck! Bottle shaped containers accepted. Remove caps, rinse and flatten.. Labels and rings removed only if easy to do so. Do not tie together. No bags, wraps, motor or cooking oil bottles. No bottles that containing toxic materials.



PAPER: Includes newspaper, office, computer, and school paper; junk mail and magazines. Paper should be clean and dry and placed in a brown paper bag or bundled. No soiled paper, paper coated with tinfoil, glitter, or glues, no cellophane or foil coated wrapping paper.



CARDBOARD: Must be corrugated (brown on inside when torn). Should be clean and dry, flattened and boxed, bagged or bundled. Brown paper grocery bags recycled with cardboard. No cardboard coated with wax, tin, plastic or contaminated from food.



GLASS: Clear, green, and amber. No lids, caps or rings. Clean and separate by color. No window glass, light bulbs, clay, ceramics, drinking glasses or ovenware.

CANS: Tin, steel, bi-metal, and aluminum. Coated cans, foil and pie tins are ok. Labels removed if possible. Clean well and flatten.

USED MOTOR OIL: Save in a leak-proof container. Drop off at a designated drop off site.
